Questions:	
1.	Verses 1-4 make some arguments that are then given backed up in verses 5-14. What are six points being made in verses 1-4?
2.	Using the six arguments you answered above, (if possible) match the "proof-texts" from verses 5-14 to the point(s) they are proving.
3.	How did God communicate with His people in the past? How does He speak to us now?
4.	To whom is Jesus being compared in chapter 1? How does He compare?

Personal Thought Questions:

- 1. In this chapter, Jesus is described as God's Son, Heir, Creator, and King. Does *your* daily life (actions and thoughts) reflect that *you* acknowledge His position?
- 2. Hebrews 2:1 will make the application of this chapter: If God now speaks through Jesus, and Jesus is better, then "we must pay much closer attention" to what He says. Do *you* pay close attention to what is said in scriptures?
