

Important Verses:

Ex. 19-20; Duet. 33:2; Ps. 68:17; Acts 7:38, 53; Gal. 3:19; 1 Tim. 4:11-16; Ps. 8:4-6; 1 Cor. 15:27, 25; Ps. 22:22; Isa. 8:17-18; 12:2; 2 Sam. 22:3; Heb. 4:15

Questions:

1. Verse 1 tells us that “we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard” - What is the “reason” that we “must” do this? What is the goal (i.e. the “so that...”) of paying closer attention?
2. Verse 2 - What was the “word spoken through angels”?
3. How does man compare to angels? What did Jesus have to do (OR what had to be done to Him) in order for Him to become like us in this comparison?
4. How did Jesus defeat the devil (Vs. 14)? How did Jesus free us from slavery (Vs. 15)? How is Jesus able to come to our aid in verse 18?

Personal Thought Questions:

1. The dangers in verses 1 and 3 are “drifting away from [the word]” and “neglect[ing] so great a salvation” - In what ways have *you* drifted from the word OR neglected the salvation?
2. Verse 15 talks of slavery because of fear of death. In what ways have you been enslaved by fear? What about, specifically, the “fear of death”?
