## **Questions:**

2. What phrase (or word) from Psalm 95 is being given further explanation in this chapter? What other OT passage is being used to explain this concept?

3. What is the author imploring the audience to do? (Vss. 1, 3, <u>11</u>, 14)

4. Verses 15-16 introduce the next section within the discussion of Jesus as a High Priest, what kind of High Priest do these verses describe Him as being? (Hint: Look back at 2:17 to see the first outline of this section)

## Personal Thought Questions:

- 1. The need for "rest" implies something that we need "rest" from. What is it in *your* life that makes *your* need for rest clear?
- 2. This section has been emphasizing that we remain faithful to the word of God as Jesus has been faithful as a High Priest, so that we may enter the rest found in Him. In what ways have *you* "hardened your heart" against the word of God?
